0-3	1- Lifts head when held on shoulder 2- Smiles spontaneously 3- Responds to bell or rattle 4- Follows moving person with eyes 5- Follows objects in a half-circle with eyes 6- Vocalizes (not crying such as "ah," "eh," or cooing)
3-5	7- Smiles responsively 8- Laughs 9- Rolls over 10- In sitting position, head is erect and steady 11- Smiles at mirror image 12- Both hands approach offered object (ball or rattle) 13- Begins crawling movements
5-9	14- Transfers objects from hand to hand 15- Sits without support 16- Squeals with joy or pleasures 17- Reaches and grasps toy 18- Holds two toys or two cubes

11-15	29- Walks alone, toddling 30- Uses a pincer grasp, as in picking up a raisin 31- Indicates or gestures wants without crying 32- Imitates words (RECORD WORDS THE CHILD USES ABOVE) 33- Drinks from a cup
12-18	34- Turns pages in a book 35- Uses at least 3 words other than "mama" and "daddy" (or variations) 36- Stacks 2 or more blocks 37- Scribbles spontaneously
15-22	38- Removes at least one garment 39- Walks backwards 40- Stacks at least 3 blocks 41- Walks up steps without help 42- Carries and hugs doll or toy animal
14-27	43- Throws ball overhand 44- Runs 45- Uses spoon (with or without spilling) 46- Names at least three objects or pictures of objects 47- Points to parts of a doll (hair, mouth, hands, feet, etc.) 48- Uses words to make wants known
